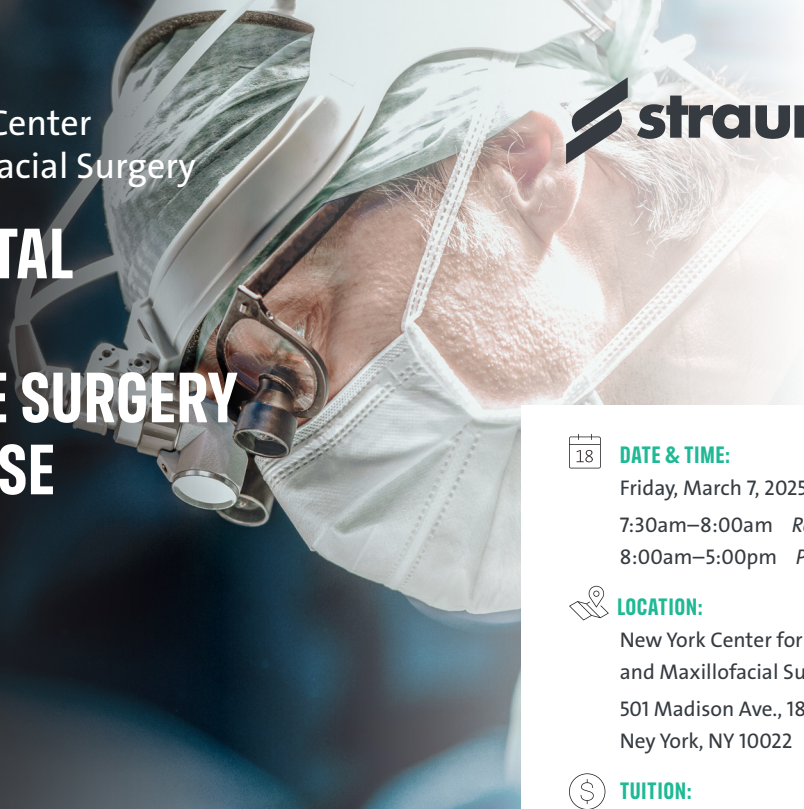

EVOLUTIONS IN DENTAL IMPLANT DIGITAL WORKFLOWS: A LIVE SURGERY OBSERVATION COURSE



This live surgical observation course will introduce the implant team to innovations in digital implant dentistry from surgical treatment planning to simplified restorative protocols. Participants will learn about simplified implant workflows applicable to the modern day implant practice.

OBJECTIVES

- Maximizing implant choice for site specific care while not compromising prosthetic connectivity
- Live single tooth placement with digital workflow for immediate load
- Live full arch immediate load surgery and prosthetics
- Restorative and laboratory demonstration for single tooth immediate load and full arch provisional fabrication
- Demonstration of multiple immediate full arch fabrication options including denture conversion, photogrammetry systems, and same day milling and printing capabilities

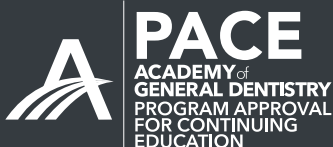
