This two day course will educate participants to identify indications for Full Arch treatment and provide a safe environment to build confidence by placing implants on cadavers. The goal of this course is to gain the knowledge and practice the skills needed to begin to introduce and incorporate Full Arch reconstruction into your practice. In preparation for our cadaver surgery, we go over the step by step full arch protocol on bone like models. Perform the alveoplasty, place 8 implants, practice timing the implant, and orienting the abutment all for a perfect Full Arch dental implant surgery. In addition to hands on implant placement, we will practice converting a denture prosthesis onto abutments, as well as learn to fabricate an intra-oral jig for your final abutment level impression. Have a case? Bring it with you and we can plan and strategize together!

- Review immediate loading protocols
- Discuss the importance of safely placing implants to achieve esthetic results
- Perform full arch conversion on models and cadavers

DR. CLARK DAMON

DR. DAMON, a native Texan, attended University of Texas Dental School followed by a 1 year General Practice Residency at the Michael E DeBakey Veterans Affairs Hospital in Houston. He has 3 offices throughout Texas dedicated to Full Arch Implant restorations and performs 25 Arches a month. Cases are performed under IV Sedation or General Anesthesia. Dr. Damon provides Standard All on Four Implant placement as well as advanced techniques with Trans Sinus and Zygomatic implants to restore cases with more limited bone volumes. For his Full Arch restorations, Dr. Damon has several CAD/CAM technicians and removable technicians at his Fort Worth, TX Dental Lab - Bite Rite. We utilize 3 - 5 axis dental mills to mill all of our products in house. Since 2015 we have milled full thickness zirconia restorations and today experiment with modern CAD/CAM materials and techniques such as PEKKTON, nano-ceramic materials on a titanium bar, and Acetyl (POM) materials. Dr. Damon is currently a Key Opinion Leader for Neodent, lectures Neodent. Dr. Damon has been course director and CEO of Texas Implant Institute since our first program in January 2019. Since our beginning we have educated over 200 clinicians in the hands on cadaver program and hundreds through informative evening lectures.
