


The Full Arch Digital Workflow: Team Approach To Treatment Planning And Restorative Options



This course provides an in-depth overview of full-arch implant treatment planning and surgical protocols for patients with terminal dentition. Participants will review pre-surgical evaluation, surgical sequencing, and post-surgical considerations. Hands-on exercises include tissue reflection, alveoplasty, placement of two axial and two tilted implants, placement of multi-unit abutments, and suturing on human cadaver specimens (no animal or printed models). A four-hour recorded lecture and video demonstrations are included for participants to view prior to the course.

OBJECTIVES

- Describe key steps in evaluating and treatment-planning a full-arch implant case.
- Identify surgical considerations and sequencing for alveoplasty, implant placement, and multi-unit abutment selection.
- Demonstrate soft-tissue reflection, implant placement, and suturing techniques on a human cadaver specimen.
